Event Name & Date: INDEPENDENCE DAY 15 Aug 2024



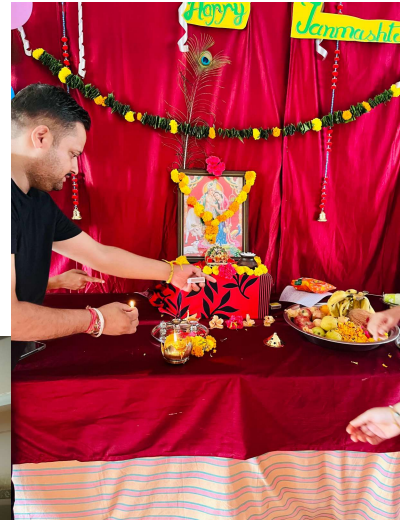

Teacher's Day

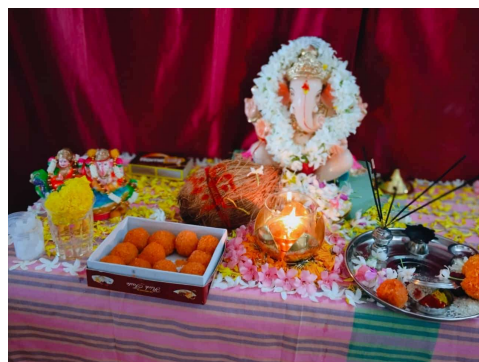

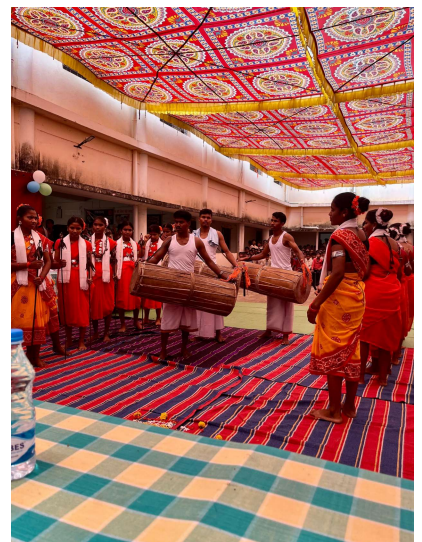


EMRS Cultural Fest 2024

Sambhagh Level



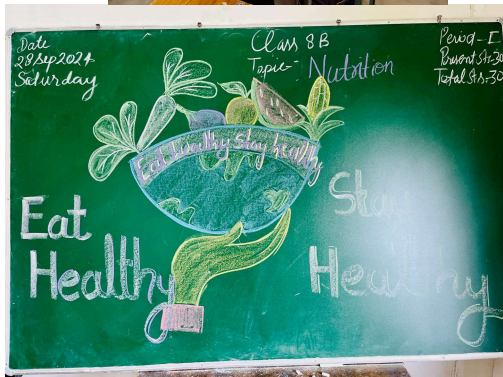
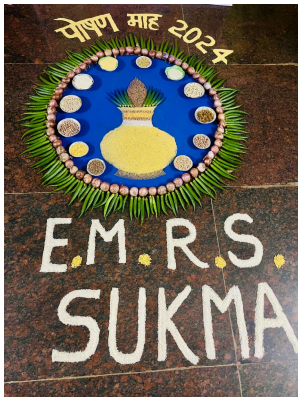
T.B Awareness Campaign -23/09/24

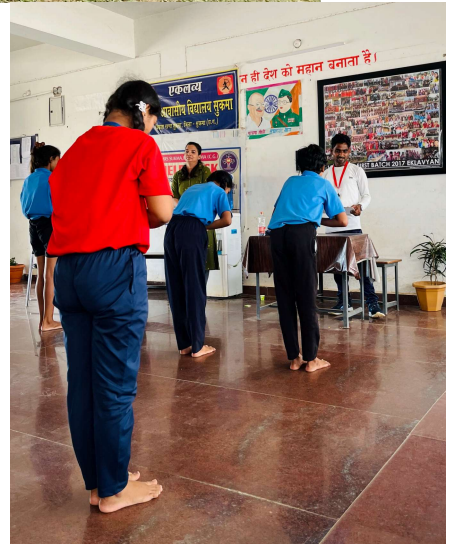

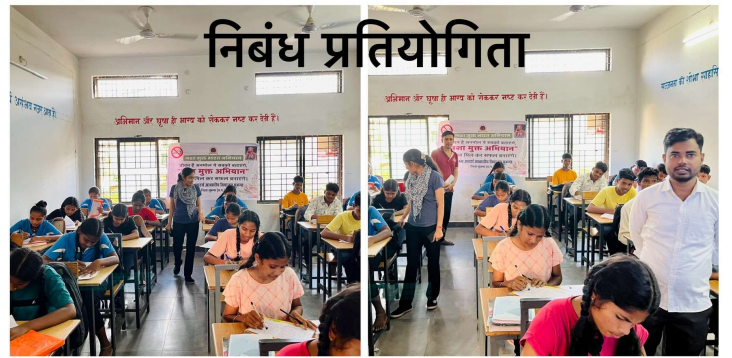
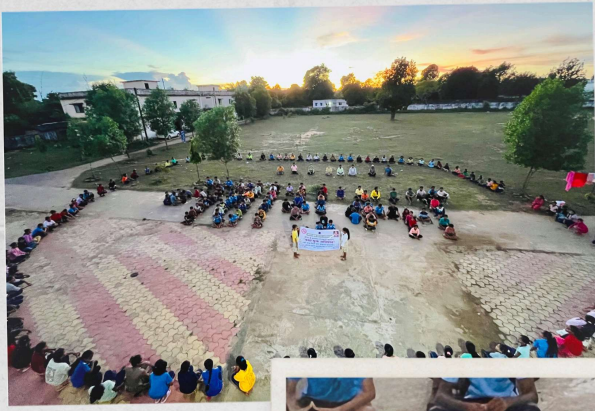




Nasha Mukat Bharat Abhiyan

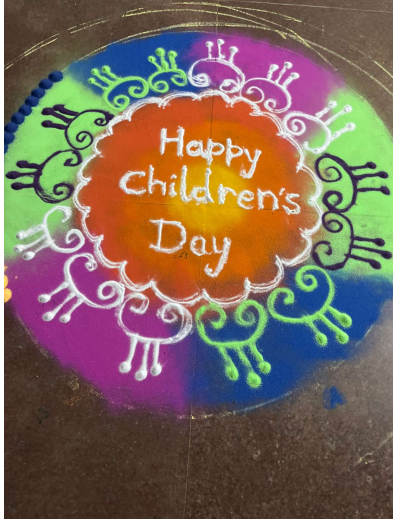

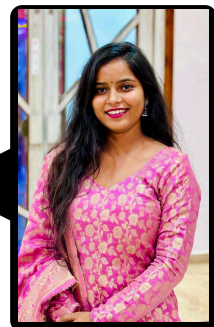

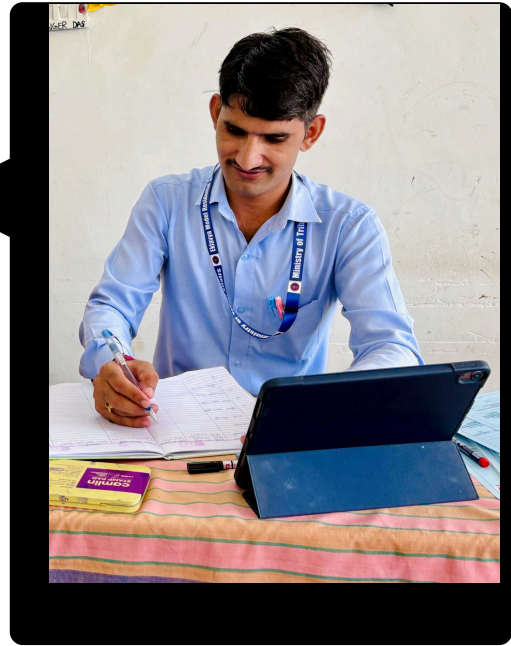
