# **Admission Process in EMRS Sukma**

#### 1. Notification of Entrance Exam

- Every year, the National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS) issues a notification for admission to Class VI.
- Notifications are released through:
  - o EMRS/NESTS official website
  - District Education Offices
  - Local newspapers and media

### 2. Eligibility Criteria

- Community: Applicant must belong to the Scheduled Tribe (ST) community.
- Education: Must have passed Class V from a recognized school.
- Age Limit: Between 10–13 years at the time of admission.

## 3. Application Process

- Applications are accepted **online only** through the official EMRS/NESTS portal.
- Required documents include:
  - o Caste Certificate
  - Birth Certificate
  - o Aadhaar Card
  - Domicile Certificate
  - o Recent Passport-size Photograph

### 4. Entrance Examination (for Class VI)

- Admission is **strictly through EMRS Entrance Test** conducted by NESTS.
- Subjects covered:
  - Mental Ability
  - o Mathematics

- o Language
- o Environmental Studies

#### 5. Selection & Merit List

- A district-wise/region-wise merit list is prepared.
- **60 students** are admitted in Class VI per school:
  - o **30 Boys**
  - o 30 Girls
- Reservation norms are followed for:
  - o PwD (Persons with Disabilities)
  - o Orphans and other eligible categories

#### 6. Admission to Higher Classes (VII-XI)

- Class VII onwards: Admission only through promotion of existing students.
- Lateral Entry Test : Allowed only if there are vacant seats.
- Class XI: Admission in Science and Commerce based on Class X results (Merit basis).

#### 7. Residential & Academic Facilities

- All selected students receive **free facilities**, including:
  - Hostel accommodation
  - o Meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks)
  - School uniforms
  - Textbooks and study material
  - Healthcare support
- EMRS are **fully residential** and funded by the **Government of India**.
